

Guidelines

General

You must be 13 years old or older to use the Harvest Community Church Table. Minors must have permission from a parent or legal guardian to use The Table.

Please use a profile picture of yourself, not of your cat or celebrity look-alike. This is a great way to learn and remember names.

Keep content appropriate. (i.e. As a non-profit organization, Harvest Community Church is restricted in support of political causes or candidates and will remove any related content.)

Don't post on behalf of another person or family unless you have received their permission.

The Table Project and Harvest Community Church reserve the right to remove content that doesn't abide by these guidelines.

Prayer Wall Guidelines

A few things to keep in mind when posting on the Prayer Wall:

1. Speak for yourself.
2. As you share personal information, please consider if it is suitable for public knowledge – for yourself, your spouse, your family, your Aunt Marge and your coworker Bill.
3. When posting a request on behalf of another person:
 - a. Ask permission from the person before posting when possible.
 - b. Maintain confidentiality. Only include information the person is comfortable communicating publicly.
 - c. Ask yourself, "How would I feel if someone else shared this information about me?"
4. Remember, God knows our situations and our needs. Sometimes you don't need to broadcast all the details but simply invite others to join you in asking God for His presence and provision.
5. Don't use the Prayer Wall for solicitation purposes. Certainly ask for prayer for general needs, but specific needs like finding daycare or someone to buy your car are best accomplished through the Needs Board or the Serve Application on The Table.
6. The Prayer Wall isn't a place to vent. If a matter is between you and another person, keep it that way.

Guidelines Continued

Serve App

The Serve App is about giving, receiving and sharing, not buying or selling. Please post only free items or items you're willing to share with minimal strings attached. If you really want to sell your grandma's china but missed out on the Antique Road Show, try eBay or the "Discussion Board" app.

Keep it appropriate

Is it really a need? Consider the value of people's time, energy and resources when posting. Sure, we'd all love someone to come clean our house once a week—but is it something you can't handle on your own, or just something you'd rather not? On the flip side, we are the body of Christ. We take care of each other. Sometimes we just need to know how.

Ask first

If you are aware of a person or family's need at Harvest Community Church, suggest they post it themselves on The Table. Don't post on behalf of another person or family unless you have received their permission.

Make it timely

Please keep postings current (within 90 days of a serving opportunity or need) and delete postings that have been fulfilled ahead of their built-in expiration.
